

MARIOTTI LUMBER



Mariotti Building Products, as it is known today was founded in the mid 1950's by Louis Mariotti Sr., a master woodworking craftsman, and his wife, Sestina. At that time the company was located on Main Street in Old Forge and was known as Mariotti Lumber Company, and it was primarily engaged in residential remodeling and construction.

In the early 1960's Mr. Mariotti's sons, Eugene, Robert and Louis Jr., joined the company. Shortly afterwards the company changed directions and decided to become a supplier of building materials to construction firms, contractors and homeowners.

Over the past 30 years the company has grown tremendously and an average sales day in 1989 will almost surpass a total sales year in 1960. The company has survived two major fires, one in 1965 and one in 1972, and it has recently moved into a brand new state of the art facility on Moosic Road in Old Forge. Mariotti Building Products now employs 90 people from the Wilkes Barre-Scranton area, and has a 23 truck fleet.

Business has increased almost every year since the early 1960's and the company is now well known throughout northeastern and central Pennsylvania. Mr. Mariotti and his three sons still run the facility as a family business and recently several of his grandsons have become involved in the company.

The Mariotti family greatly appreciates the support and patronage from the people of the Triboro area, and from those throughout all of northeastern and central Pennsylvania. They hope that the citizens of these communities continue to show their confidence in the Mariotti family and its business.
